2020 Census – It Is Important

- Determines the number of seats each state has in the U.S. House of Representatives
- Defines congressional and state legislative districts, school districts and voting precincts
- Medicaid, SNAP, Hwy Planning, Section 8 Housing, Special Education Grants, S-CHIP, Title I Grants, National School Lunch Program, WIC, Head Start, Foster Care, Health Center Programs
- Provides insight to governments, business and community planning groups for planning purposes

March 12-20	An invitation to respond online to the 2020 Census. (Some households will also receive paper questionnaires.)
March 16-24	A reminder letter.
	If you haven't responded yet:
March 26-April 3	A reminder postcard.
April 8-16	A reminder letter and paper questionnaire.
April 20-27	A final reminder postcard before we follow up in person.

2020 Census – It Is Easy

- Four ways to respond in 2020
 - Online
 - Phone
 - Paper
 - Personal Visit by Census Employee
- Name, sex, age and DOB, race, Hispanic origin, stay elsewhere, relationship, household questions (pop count, housing tenure, phone number)

We will never ask for:

- Your social security number.
- Money or donations.
- Anything on behalf of a political party.
- Your bank or credit card account numbers.
